**Permission - Epinephrine Injector**

Schools are now authorized to give **emergency** epinephrine by school trained staff under certain conditions when the school nurse is unavailable. Designated and trained staff may administer epinephrine in the form of an auto-injector during a *severe, life-threatening allergic reaction* (anaphylaxis) without a doctor's order. The epinephrine injector delivers a pre-measured, sterile, single dose of epinephrine through the skin (CT Public Act # 14-176).
